### Daily Forecasts: April 6–April 11

April 6

#### Alignment

Mars conjunct Neptune; Mars sextile Uranus (applying); Jupiter square Sun; Jupiter trine Mercury; Moon in Sagittarius

---

**Forecast:** The public begins constructing meaning out of unclear events for themselves. Emerging recognition of coming action and subsequent consequences, resulting in increased receptivity towards leadership due to perceived lack of options. Emotionally compelling but unconfirmed narratives spread quickly and drive the reframing of public sentiment. The entire system stands at the threshold of imminent action with potentially far-reaching consequences that are, as yet, poorly understood.

April 7

#### Alignment

Mars conjunct Neptune (tighter); Mars sextile Uranus (very tight); Jupiter square Sun; Jupiter trine Mercury; Moon in Sagittarius

**Forecast:** Narratives and extrapolated meaning begin to harden into provisional certainties. Increasing public acceptance of and commitment to perceived inevitability of consequences. The system appears to remain on the brink, but this does not seem to be the ignition moment. Possible beginning of escalatory martial action within evening hours, if it has not already begun by then.

April 8

#### Alignment

Mars conjunct Neptune; Mars sextile Uranus (near exact); Jupiter square Sun; Jupiter trine Mercury; Moon ingresses Capricorn

**Forecast:** Action under extreme ambiguity - forceful developments emerge suddenly and without a clear origin, creating a storm of conflicting, emotionally driven narratives. The public, finally thinking sober-mindedly about the current action and its consequences, is primarily concerned with the potential fallout from the actively unfolding situation, specifically pertaining to the flow of material goods.

## April 9

### Alignment

Mars ingresses Aries (3:35 PM EDT); Mars conjunct Neptune (still active across sign boundary); Mars sextile Uranus; Mars sextile Pluto; Jupiter square Sun; Moon in Capricorn

**Forecast:** This is an extremely high-pressure environment that's simultaneously deeply ambiguous. There's a lot of war and a lot of fog. Unclear but forceful actions are triggering a real-world disruption of materials, and underlying systems are in the process of imposing inevitable consequences, themselves not entirely understood. Public anxiety is high, and narratives are fragmented, incomplete, chaotic and conflicting.

## April 10

### Alignment

Mars in early Aries; Mars conjunct Neptune (separating); Mars sextile Uranus; Mars sextile Pluto; Jupiter square Sun; Moon ingresses Aquarius (7:56 PM EDT)

---

**Forecast:** This is a threshold-crossing moment in which a high-impact, high-reverb event is suddenly initiated as the martial energy sharply escalates, though real-time details are even further obscured and confused. This is triggered abruptly, likely with little to no warning, and executed with decisive and penetrating force. Leadership acts from a place of necessity now, with no good options on the table. Collective attention drawn to systems, responses, and consequences that are potentially uncontrollable or irreversible.

## April 11

### Alignment

Mars conjunct Neptune (wider, but still active); Mars sextile Pluto; Jupiter square Sun; Moon conjunct Pluto; Moon in Aquarius

**Forecast:** Escalation. Aggressive action continues in an atmosphere of ambiguity and uncertainty, frequently via sudden or opportunistic attacks. But once the wire has been tripped the blowback is immediate. System-level reactions on all fronts, people simply along for the ride. Proxy responses likely. Global rush to secure the flow of material goods under perceived extreme instability. All combines to produce outcomes that harden quickly and are difficult to unwind.
